• **Elm Grove Home for Seniors:** Senior residence facility where Sherry and Janelle live.

Elm Grove, Southsea, England. Location of A.C. Doyle's medical practice.

• The "Sibling Streets": Kingsley, Percy, Adrian, and Annette Street, in Acie's subdivision. Acie lives on Norwood Street, and Doyle lived in South Norwood at one time.

The streets were named for Doyle's children

- **Beacon Golf Club:** Location near where the new Sanctuary will be placed. Beacon Golf Club in East Sussex where Doyle lived for at time.
- **Barrymore's Cafe:** Cafe and coffee shop in town where Ike and Meryl were spotted, 'canoodling'

Mr. Barrymore and his wife were the butler and cook in *Hound of the Baskervilles*.

• **Bloody Vixen Tor:** Location at the city park where Henrietta was found. Location on the moor in *Hound of the Baskervilles*
