*Thomas Lefroy, a suitor who proposed to Jane Austen*

- **Joan Murray**, Editor of the Barn & Bugle newspaper  
*John Murray, one of Jane Austen's publishers*
- **Detective Forster, Officer Carter**: Police officers  
*Colonel Forster, Captain Carter (officers stationed near Longbourn)*
- **Persuasion**, Jane's cat
- **Franny, Cassie, Georgie, Jamie, Edie (Knight), Charlene (Charlie), and Henrietta (Hank)**: The Bossy Posse, a circle of friends who critique Jane's books; Hank and Jamie are married; Charlie and Edie are married; Fran and Cassie are sisters.
